

PDF Instructions for your Authors

Before Creating a PDF

- Add the copyright notice to the bottom of the first page of your source document. If necessary, contact **Mr. Jamshaid Iqbal Janjua** at jamshaid.janjua@kics.edu.pk for the appropriate copyright notice.
- The appropriate copyright clearance code notice is to appear on the bottom of the first page of each paper according to the guidelines set forth in the Cataloging/Copyright Instructions for an IEEE Conference Proceeding. Detailed instructions can be found at: <http://www.ieee.org/portal/pages/about/documentation/copyright/cfrmlink.html>
 - For papers in which all authors are employed by the US government, the copyright notice is: **U.S. Government work not protected by U.S. copyright**
 - For papers in which all authors are employed by a Crown government (UK, Canada, and Australia), the copyright notice is: **978-1-5090-5586-9/16/\$31.00 ©2016 Crown**
 - For papers in which all authors are employed by the European Union, the copyright notice is: **978-1-5090-5586-9/16/\$31.00©2016 European Union**
 - For all other papers the copyright notice is: **978-1-5090-5586-9/16/\$31.00 ©2016 IEEE**
- Proofread your source document thoroughly to confirm that it will require no revision.

Creating your PDF eXpress Account

Log in to the [IEEE PDF eXpress™ site](#)

First-time users should do the following:

1. Select the New Users - Click Here link.
2. Enter the following:
 - **35808X** for the Conference ID
 - Your email address
 - A password
3. Continue to enter information as prompted.

An Online confirmation will be displayed and an email confirmation will be sent verifying your account setup.

Previous users of PDF eXpress need to follow the above steps, but should enter the same password that was used for previous conferences. Verify that your contact information is valid.
